Hakata-gochou
Considered the center of "Fukuoka's high-rise paradise." Covers 5 areas: Kamikawabata Street, Shimokawabata Street, Kotobuki Street, Kasuga Town and Tsurabata Town. Kabuki is performed at Hakata-za. International brand shops are inside Emyery Miny Mo and the Fukuoka Asian Art Museum is inside Hakata Riverain.
